A member of the Board of Advisors is one who:

- Shares the vision and philosophy of Holy Family Academy
- Agrees to sign a profession of faith and an oath of fidelity to the Roman Catholic Church
- Is committed to attending the quarterly meetings of the Board of Advisors
- Is willing to serve on a least one standing committee to attend the committee's meetings and complete any tasks relevant to the work of the committee
- Is willing to be called on beyond regular meetings to advise and assist in specific areas of need relative to their area of expertise
- Is willing to pray daily, and fast the first Friday of every month, for the Academy, the Board of Trustees, and its' benefactors

The quarterly meetings of the Board of Advisors will include the Board of Trustees and upon invitation the administrator of the Academy. The purpose of the meetings will be to build a cohesive working unit, to be updated on the status of the Academy, to seek and receive the advice of the advisors, to be updated on the work of the standing committees and above all to pray for the school and to discern God's vision for the Academy.

The initial term of service is for two years with the possibility of an invitation to renew that service for an additional term.
